Showcasing works spanning six centuries of printmaking, the Fair will include significant pieces by world-renowned artists such as Hockney, Rego, Milhazes, Picasso and Matisse. New works by Adam Dant, Marc Quinn, Grayson Perry and Claudette Johnson will be launched at the Fair, alongside a special tribute to British Pop Art pioneerJoe Tilson.

Founded in 1985, LOPF is London's longest-running art fair, providing visitors with an unparalleled opportunity to explore, learn about and collect works by the world's greatest masters and new pieces by rising talents hot off the press.
