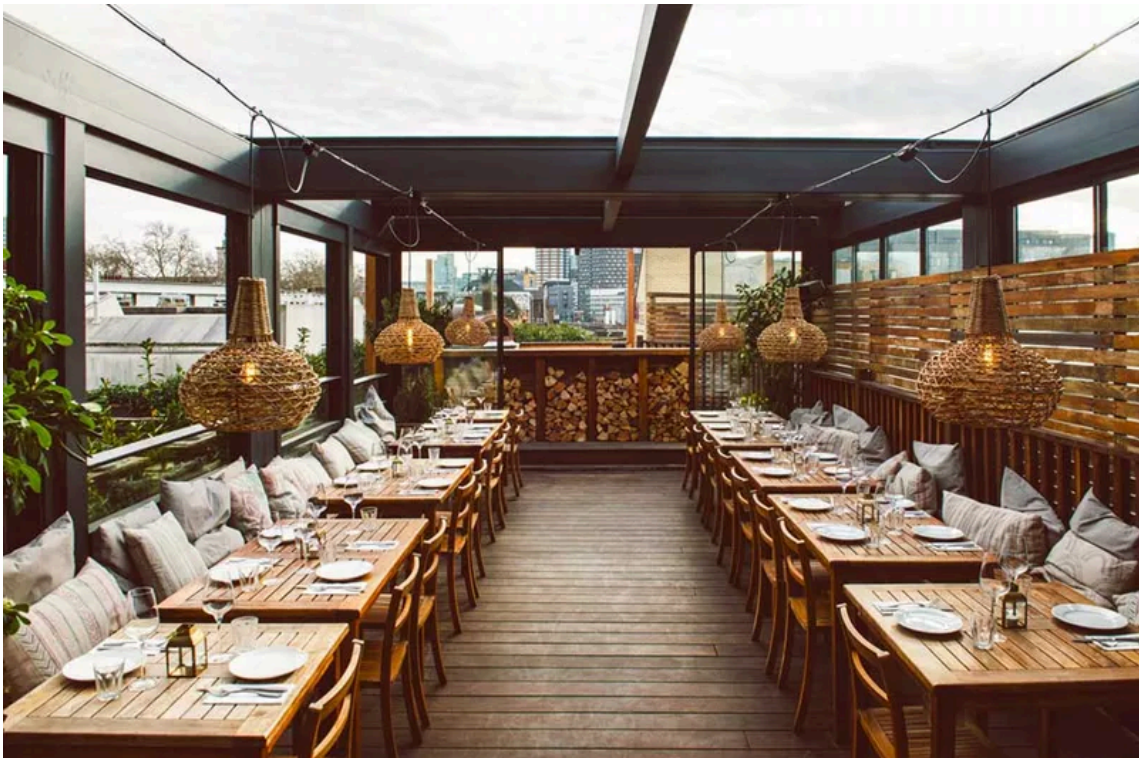
REVIVE YOUR INTERIORS:
